AMECO supplied fully maintained construction equipment including maintenance parts and labour, fuel, transportation and insurance as well as small tools, supplies, consumables and safety items. At project peak, AMECO provided 340 pieces of construction equipment. This made up 176 major fueled items that included 6 conventional crawler cranes ranging from 100 – 400 tons and 9 mobile RT cranes ranging from 8 – 100 tons in capacity.
